National Traffic Safety Institute (NTSI), the United States Army Combat Readiness Center (USACRC), and Firehouse Pictures Film Army Traffic Safety Training Videos at Fort Rucker

Tucson, Arizona September 19, 2006

The National Traffic Safety Institute (NTSI), the United States Army Combat Readiness Center (USACRC), and Firehouse Pictures filmed the final two installments of the Army Traffic Safety Training Program September 11-15 at Fort Rucker. The videos fulfill the Department of Defense requirements that all army personnel under the age of 26 complete traffic safety training, which also includes training videos for supervisors. Paul Hallums, President of NTSI, said "'NTSI is extremely proud to be producing a series of driver safety programs for the United States Army. These programs will save many young lives and help promote the readiness of our armed forces."

NTSI was awarded the contract by the Installation Management Agency (IMA) to develop curriculum for the Army Traffic Safety Training Program in the spring of 2006. Since that time, NTSI has developed 5 traffic safety courses, including an on-line version, as well as a promotional video distributed to army installations all over the world. As of the date of this press release, the USACRC has reported a significant decrease in the number of traffic accidents.
